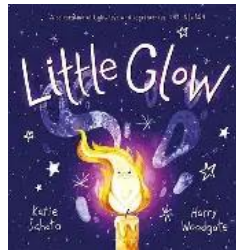

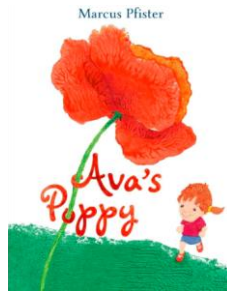

- Posting letters

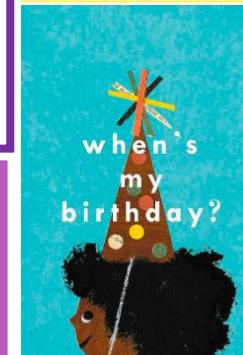
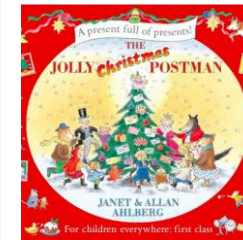
I will know:

Can you write a card to someone special? (i.e. birthday card, Christmas card etc.)



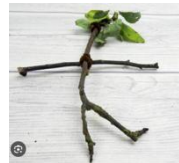
Wish list
